DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 Arrive Jeju

Make your way to South Korea's largest island, Jeju, where you will be met by a driver and transferred to your hotel to check in.

Flights to Jeju Island are not included in the base package but can be added, usually with a supplement.



Destination Information

Jeju Island – Jeju Island has long featured as the country's top domestic travel destination, attracting people from across the country with its beautiful beaches, lush countryside and fresh seafood.

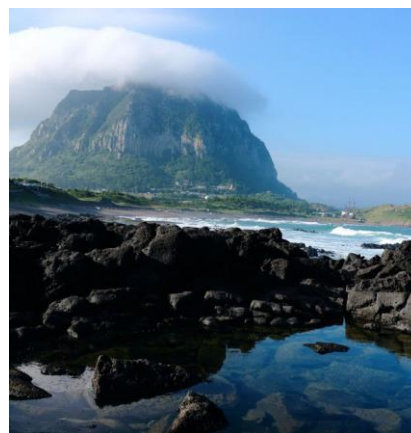
Day 2: Jeju Island

Meals: B, L

This morning, head to the pick-up point to begin your full day tour of Jeju Island (West Course) with a visit to the stunning white sands of Hyeopjae Beach. Afterwards, explore Hallim Park, an interesting botanical garden in Jeju City.

After lunch, go on to see the Osulloc green tea field and Mt Songak. You will also visit Cheonjiyeon Waterfalls or the Teddy Bear Museum before returning to the drop-off point.

*Please note: You will be required to make your own travel arrangements to and from the pick-up /drop-off point (at **Parking Lot B, Jeju International Airport**) for touring on this day. Your hotel is approximately 3km or a 10-15 minute drive by taxi from the pick-up/drop-off point. The taxi fare will be approx. 6,000 KRW – 7,000 KRW per way, paid locally.*



Destination Information

Hyeopjae Beach – Hyeopjae Beach is well known for the bright white colour of the sand. The long shore stretches 9 kilometres alongside the beautiful cobalt water and evergreen forests.

Hallim Park – Overlooking the scenery of Biyangdo Island, Hallim Park was established on barren land before it was covered with earth and subtropical plants in 1971.

Songaksan Mountain – Songaksan Mountain is a mountain formed by underwater volcanic activity, characterized by its dual volcanic cones, which hold significant geological value. Along the Songaksan Trail, hikers can enjoy breathtaking coastal landscapes, including views of Hyeongjeseom Island, Gapado Island, and Marado Island.

Day 3: Jeju Island

Meals: B, L

Start your second full day with a seat-in-coach tour of Jeju Island (East Course) where you will first explore Jeolmul Forest, followed by a visit to Seongeup Folk Village.

After lunch, witness the work of the Haenyeo, Jeju's female divers who harvest shellfish for a living. The Haenyeo are renowned for their ability to dive up to 10 metres under the sea without the use of oxygen masks. Haenyeo work for up to seven hours per day. After lunch, head to Seongsan Sunrise Peak before going on to explore Jeju Stone Park.



Please note: Your itinerary may vary according to weather conditions. If the divers are unable to work on the day of your visit, you may visit the Haenyeo Museum instead.

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Destination Information

Seongeup Folk Village – At the foot of Mt Hall, Seongeup Folk Village holds a vast amount of culture dating back to 1410. With culture handed down through generations, you will find a number of gems here from Confucian shrines to ancient government offices as well as folk plays and a local dialect.

Seongsan Sunrise Peak – 5000 years ago, underwater magma flow formed the huge tuff cone of Seongsan Sunrise Peak, which rises some 180 metres above sea level. Over the years, it has become a part of Jeju Island.

Jeju Stone Park – An ecological park, Jeju Stone Park is the perfect display of the longstan stone culture and identity of Jeju Island. The primary theme of the park focuses on the myth of Seolmundae Halmang, which translates to Grandmother Seolmundae, who is believed to have been the legend behind Jeju's origin.

Day 4: Depart Jeju

Meals: B

This morning is free at leisure before you transfer to the airport for your onward flight.



JEJU ISLAND SHORT STAY TRAVEL INFORMATION

VISAS:

Visas are not required for UK/Irish passport holders for entry into South Korea.

INSURANCE:

It is a condition of booking with us that you take out suitable travel insurance. You must provide us with the name of your insurer, policy number and their 24-hour emergency contact number when you book with us or as soon as possible thereafter. These details will be available to your national escort should they be required. Wendy Wu Tours will not be liable for any costs incurred by you due to your failure to take out suitable travel insurance from the date of booking.

TRANSPORT:

Coaches: Please note, the nature of the Jeju Island tours that take place on Day 2 and 3 will be in a seat-in-coach style. This means, you will enjoy your tour within a shared coach with other passengers that may or may not be a part of a Wendy Wu Tour.

Whilst onboard, you will be accompanied by an English speaking tour guide that will also be joining you as you explore the various sites mentioned on your itinerary.

ITINERARY CHANGES:

It is our intention to adhere to the day-to-day itinerary as printed; however, the order of events or sightseeing may change as we look to improve our tours or as local conditions dictate; in these circumstances we will make the best possible arrangements whilst maintaining the integrity of your trip.

Please note:

- The West course is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- The East course touring is available on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

If Day 2 or 3 or your tour falls on a Sunday, your itinerary will differ. Please note, the South course is available on Sundays and includes a visit to the Mysterious Road, Mt. Hallasan National Park (Eoseungsaengak trail) and Alive Museum. After lunch you will continue to Jusangjeolli Cliff, Oedolgae Rock and Jeongbang Waterfalls.
